Lviv IT Cluster



In 2022, in response to the start of the full-scale invasion, Lviv IT Cluster launched a series of Victory projects aimed at supporting business, military, critical, and civilian infrastructure and reinforcing the regional security.

Over 23 months of the ongoing war in Ukraine, the Lviv IT Cluster community has allocated almost 109 million UAH (\$ 3,2 million) to Victory projects. These funds are IT companies' invaluable contribution to the present and future of the country and the manifestation of their social responsibility.

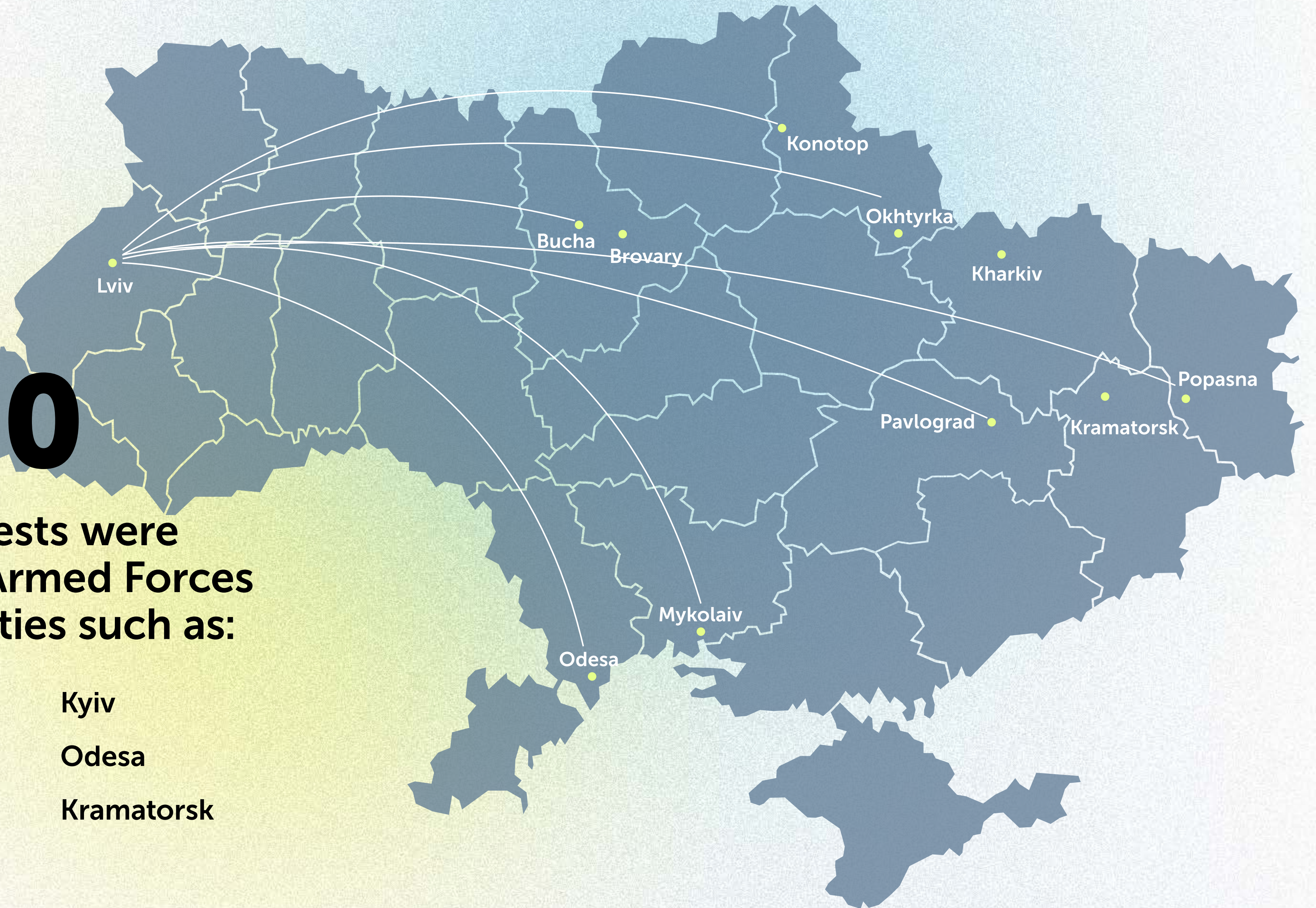

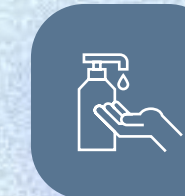

The first stage of the Air Command West modernization project included replacing existing computer equipment, network equipment, and screens for navigation display systems in the command and analytical centers.

STAGE 1

At this stage, a network of 45 mobile operation centers was created to protect the airspace in the western regions of Ukraine. This approach proved effective, and later, Air Command “West” extended the network to 108 centers, which Lviv IT Cluster provided with the necessary technical equipment.

At this stage, Lviv IT Cluster contributed to creating the backup command and analytical centers for Air Command "West" in case of the headquarters defeat. Presently the Air Command has three backup locations to continue defense operations; their sites are classified.

The next step was to purchase and upgrade the existing heavy equipment. Lviv IT Cluster financed the purchase of a tractor-trailer vehicle for the rapid weapons redeployment, upgraded the anti-aircraft system Gepard, and established communication between patrol aircraft during missions.

STAGE 4

After the intensive Air Command facilities shelling by the enemy, a decision was made to increase the security of the members of the armed forces. A reinforced command center and shelter were designed to protect personnel from ballistic missile attacks. Lviv IT Cluster has partially financed the construction and fully equipped the centers.

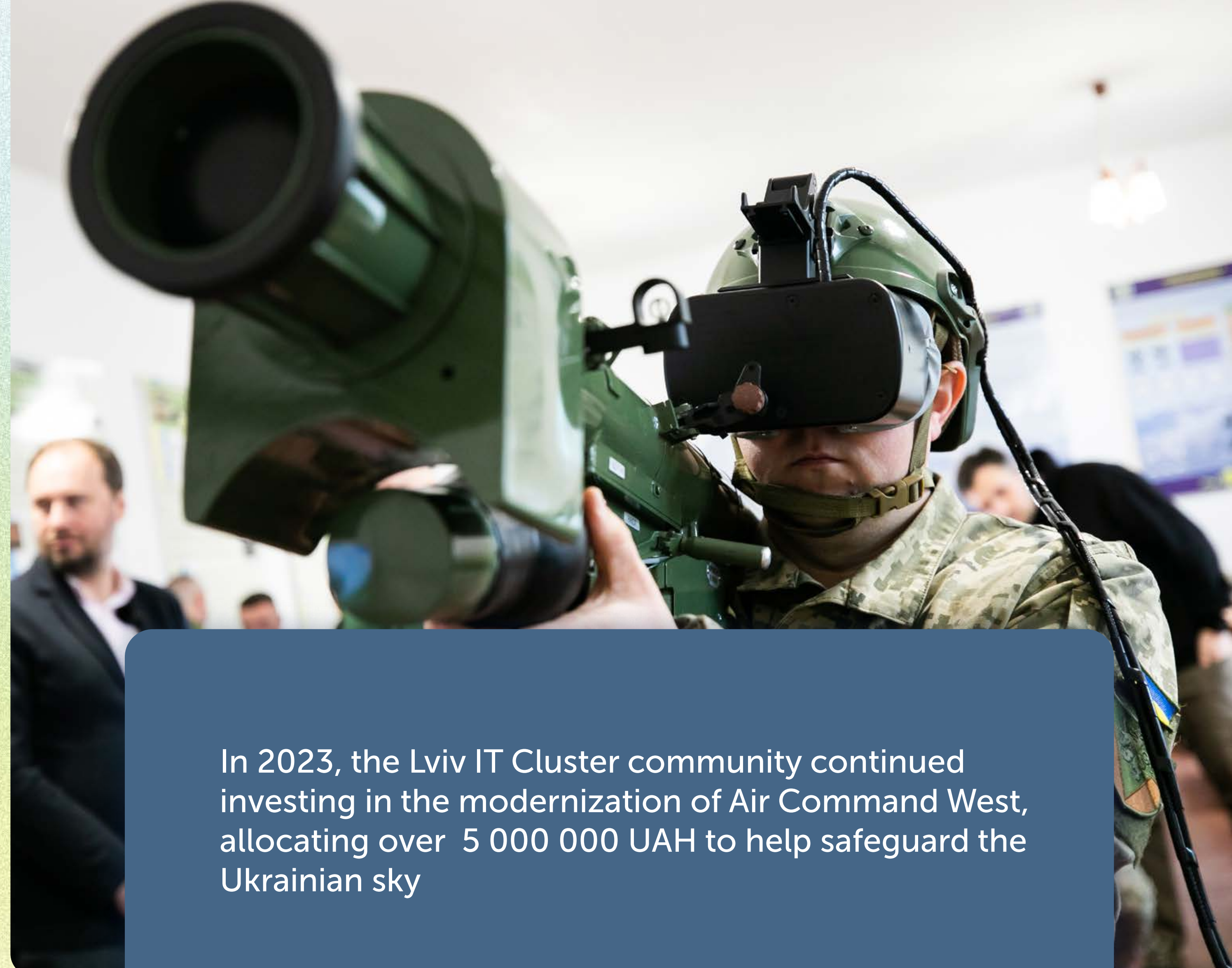

The Shahedbusters project is part of the initiative of the Lviv Military Administration, aimed at creating mobile brigades to protect the region's critical infrastructure from attacks by enemy UAVs. At the end of 2023, the Lviv IT Cluster community procured the first five cars. Pickup trucks are equipped with night vision devices, thermal imagers, and searchlights. More than 50 member companies supported the Shahedbusters initiative.

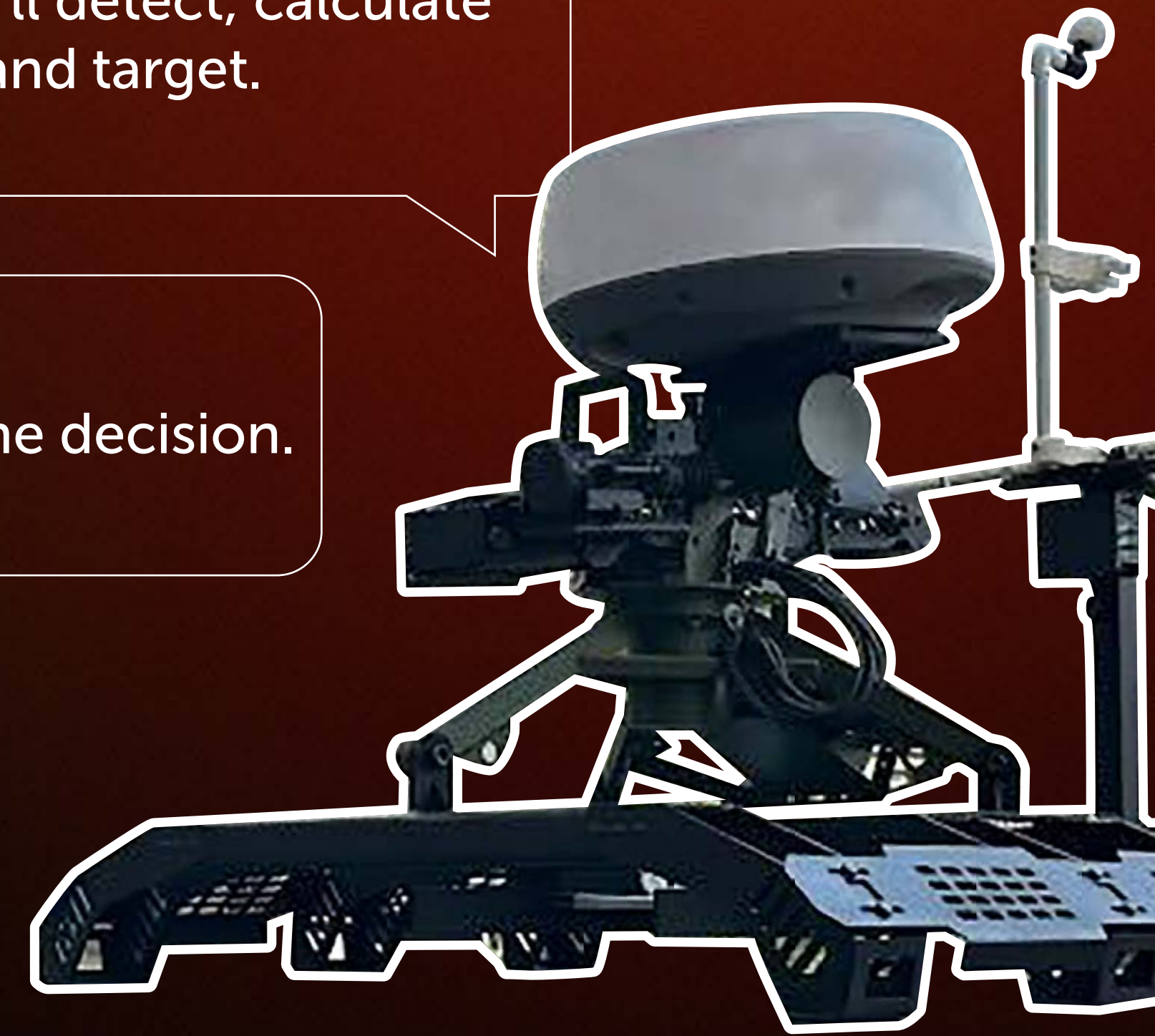

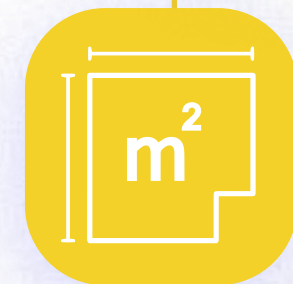

The budget for 16 Victory projects equals **2 million USD**, which is nearly **70 million UAH**. These projects are focused on three major areas: border and sky protection, as well as physical and mental rehabilitation. In two years of the full-scale invasion, the Lviv IT Cluster community invested in military armor purchase, drone pilot training, detection and elimination of enemy UAVs and missiles, and addressing mental health challenges. Still, they all share a single goal: to support the state and bring our Victory closer.
